

The format for digital submissions has changed! Dimensions are now:: two images side by side in one file, with the left 'eye' on the left. The combined image should be 960 pixels high, and up to 2560 wide. Make sure that the width of the image is an even number, or a column of pixels from one image may appear on the other image in projection. The file-naming convention is as follows.

- 1st character: A or B (group) or S (special) 2nd character: 1. 2. 3 or 4 (sequence of entry) 3rd character: Since this will be the 1st month, the 1st letter in your last name. The rest of the file name should be the title of the image.
