

Club Information

The Club meets on the third Monday of each month unless noted otherwise. Instead of a regular meeting this month we will hold the Oakland International Exhibition on Monday February 18 at 7:30pm at the LAFAYETTE VETERAN'S MEMORIAL **BUILDING** at 3780 Mt. Diablo Blvd in Lafayette. March will resume with a Double Competition.

Contributors may submit up to two sets of four images for digital projection in each category, and up to two sets of four cards. Please email all digital entries to John at jlballou@comcast.net by Friday January 25th.

The format for digital submissions is: two images side by side in one file, with the left 'eye' on the left. The combined image should be 960 pixels high, and up to 2560 wide. Make sure that the width of the image is an even number, or a column of pixels from one image may appear on the other image in projection. The file-naming convention is as follows.

- 1st character: A or B (group) or S (special) 2nd character: 1. 2. 3 or 4 (sequence of entry)
- 3rd character: Since this is the 11th month, the 11th letter in your last name, wrapping around to the beginning if necessary.
- The rest of the file name should be the title of the image.
