Club Information

The Club meets on the third Monday of each month unless noted otherwise. Our next meeting will be on Monday August 19 at 7:30pm at the ALBANY COMMUNITY CENTER at 1249 Marin Avenue in Albany.

This month, the Special Competition theme is "Food". Members may submit up to four digital images in each category, and up to four cards. Please email all digital entries to John at ilballou@comcast.net by Friday July 16th.

The format for digital submissions is: two images side by side in one file, with the left 'eye' on the left. The combined image should be 960 pixels high, and up to 2560 wide. Make sure that the width of the image is an even number, or a column of pixels from one image may appear on the other image in projection. The file-naming convention is as follows.

- 1st character: A or B (group) or S (special) 2nd character: 1. 2. 3 or 4 (sequence of entry)
- 3rd character: Since this is the 8th month, the 8th letter in your last name, wrapping around to the beginning if necessary.
- The rest of the file name should be the title of the image.
