Board elections are coming up! Open posts include: Field Trip Coordinator, Banquet Coordinator, and Historian. Contact Mat with interest.

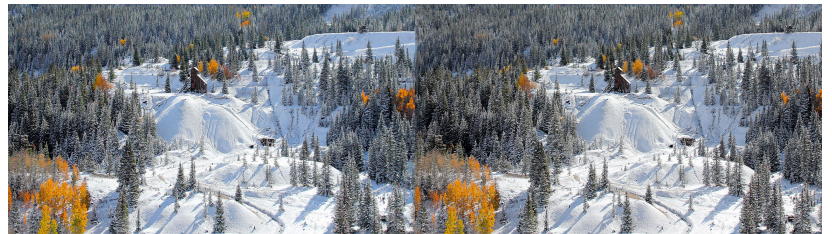
November Stereo Division Meeting

Club Information

The Club meets on the third Monday of each month unless noted otherwise. our next meeting will be on **Monday January 20** at 7:30pm at the **ALBANY COMMUNITY CENTER** at 1249 Marin Avenue in Albany. In lieu of a Special Competition we will hold a clinic, so bring in your curiosities and/or works in progress. We'll also view additional video submissions from November.

Contributors may submit two sets of up to four images each for digital projection in each category, and two sets of up to four cards each. Please email all digital entries to John at jballou@comcast.net by Friday January 17th.

The format for digital submissions is: two images side by side in one file, with the left 'eye' on the left. The combined image should be 960 pixels high, and up to 2560 wide. Make sure that the width of the image is an even number, or a column of pixels from one image may appear on the other image in projection. The file-naming convention is as follows.

- 1st character: A or B (group) or S (special)
- 2nd character: 1. 2. 3 or 4 (sequence of entry)
- 3rd character: Since this is the 1st month, the 1st letter in your last name.
- The rest of the file name should be the title of the image.
